# **Appendix A: NCSC Statement on 2019 Tuition Policy Changes**

In light of the recent provincial announcement regarding changes to the Tuition Fee policy which governs universities in Ontario

The policy will be in effect starting September 2019 and will continue for the following two academic years. The policy changes include major funding restructuring to the Ontario Student Assistance Program (OSAP), non-academic fees, and OSAP repayment periods. Further details continue to emerge through our consultations with administration and fellow student unions.

## **Summary of the Policy Changes**

OSAP Restructuring:

The threshold for OSAP recipients of a combined family income of \$175,000 will be reduced to a combined family income of \$140,000.

**Tuition Cuts:** 

Universities will be required to decrease their tuition fees by 10% and freeze tuition for another year. Universities will be required to make adjustments to makeup for lost revenue.

Opting-out of Compulsory Non-Academic Student Fees:

Non-Academic student fees will no longer be mandatory. This would mean that non-essential student fees would be required to have a opt-out process. Essential fees that will remain mandatory include Walksafe programs, health and counselling services, athletics and recreation and academic support.

We will continue to provide our students with information as we receive and advocate for our students particularly those who are affected by this policy. You are not alone and we will be with every step of the way.
